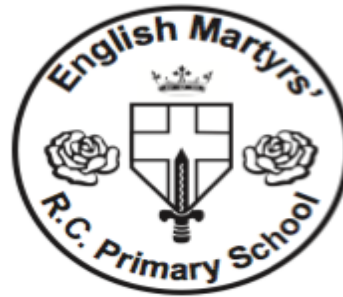

Monitoring the impact of Pupil Premium Grant

Mrs Partington (Headteacher) has overall responsibility for the attainment and progress of Pupil Premium children although ensuring the progress of eligible pupils and evidencing this is a whole-school priority.

Children's progress and attainment is tracked and monitored carefully to ensure they achieve their full potential. Regular monitoring and evaluation is key to ensuring effectiveness of expenditure.

Targets for pupils are set in maths, reading and writing and we know where we expect them to be by the end of the programme or set of lessons. Monitoring is a joint responsibility of the class teacher and Senior Leaders and regular assessment data is analysed and acted upon. The DFE also analyse our school data and compare our results to national data.

Through our termly Governing Body meeting we report clearly on data for Pupil Premium and a transparent expenditure line is maintained in our financial monitoring so governors can link value for money with impact.

We are delighted that all pupils entitled to free school meals achieved a 'Good Level of Development' at the end of Reception and the standard required in the Year1/2 phonic check, both sets of results above English Martyrs' average and significantly higher than the National and Trafford average. While pupils entitled to free school meals achieved below Trafford and National averages at the end of Years 2 and 6, small numbers of pupils entitled to free school meals in each cohort affected the results and internal monitoring clearly shows these pupils made good progress from their individual starting points.
